ANNOUNCEMENT for the POSITION of STUDIES and RESEARCH COORDINATOR in the DEPARTMENT of FOOD QUALITY & CHEMISTRY of NATURAL PRODUCTS

The Mediterranean Agronomic Institute of Chania, a constituent member of the International Centre for Advanced Mediterranean Agronomic Studies (CIHEAM) headquartered in Paris, announcing the position of "Studies and Research Coordinator for the Post-Graduate Department of Food Quality & Chemistry of Natural Products." The duration of this position is from 01.06.2017 until 31.12.2017 with a view to renewal for an indefinite period after evaluation.

The duties of the position briefly include the following responsibilities:

* Academic coordination of the "Food Quality & Chemistry of Natural Products" Department

* Organization and management of the Laboratory of Analytical Chemistry comprising equipment such as HPLC, LC-DAD-MS, LC/MS/MS, GC/MS, etc.

* Supervision of graduate theses independently and/or in cooperation with Universities and/or Research Centres in Greece or abroad.

* Submission and implementation of research and development programs

Applicants for the position should have the following qualifications:

* PhD, postdoctoral research experience and a sufficient number of publications in peer-reviewed scientific journals in one, or preferably more, of the following fields: chemistry, science and technology, food technology, analytical chemistry and/or metabolomics, pharmaceutics focusing on natural products, agronomy or biology with an emphasis on control and food quality assurance.

- * Excellent fluency in Greek and English, and any other language(s)
- * Experience in the preparation and presentation of research and development programs
- * Educational experience in academic institutions such as teaching courses and supervising students
- * Excellent communication skills and the ability to work well in a scientific team

Experience in the following is also desirable:

* Quality systems such as ISO 17025

* Development of new analytical methods with the aim of providing services

* Partnerships in the food industry on topics such as product development and food quality improvement.
